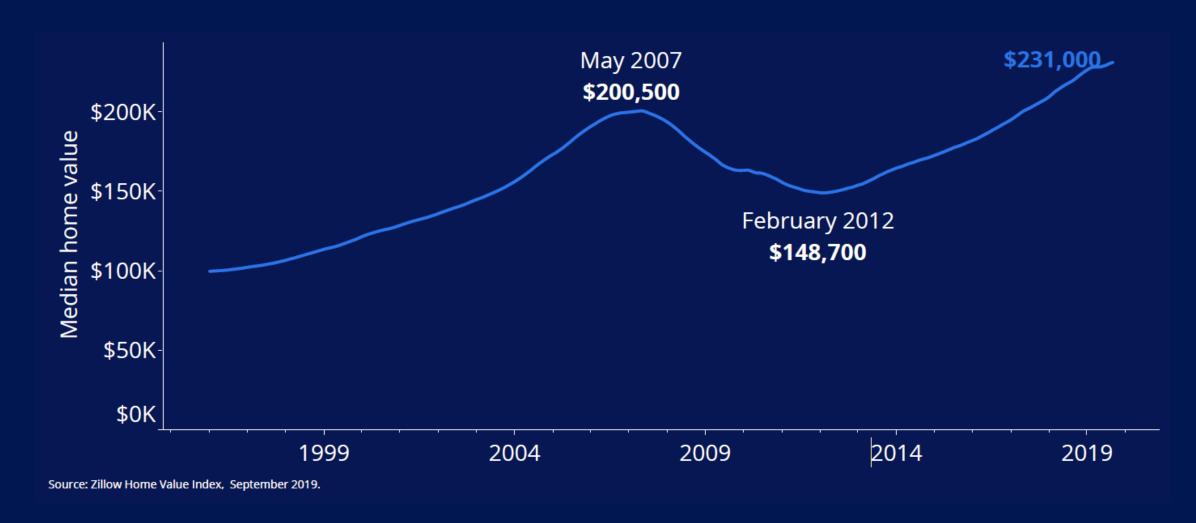

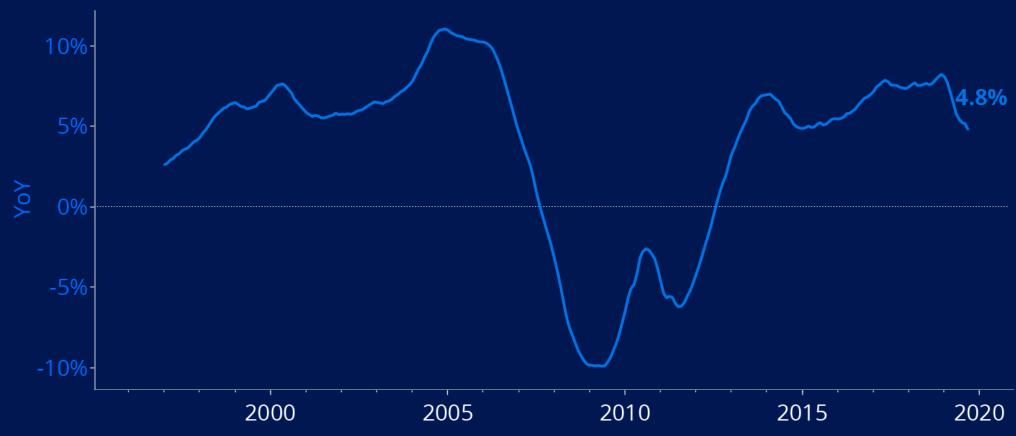

Zillow Home Value Index shows a dynamic history



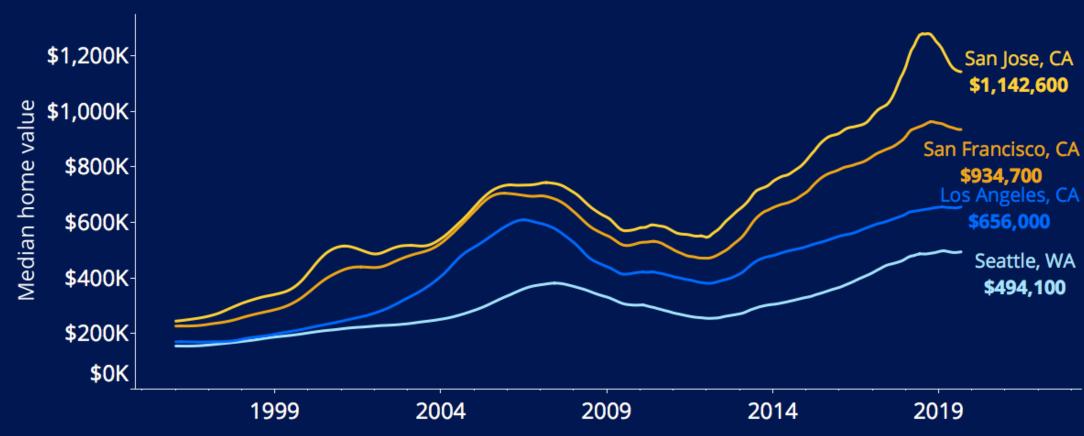
U.S. housing started slowing significantly in 2019



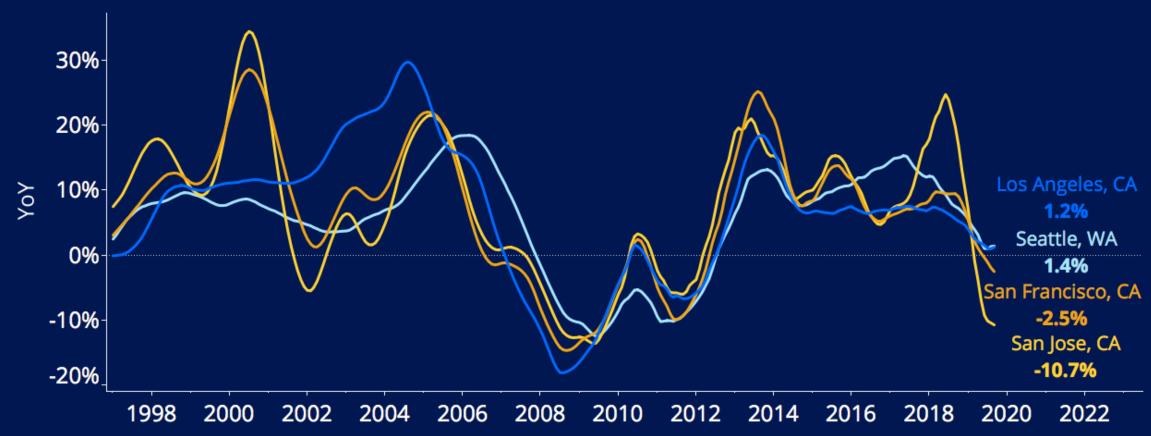
After a volatile spring, home values are now on the upswing again



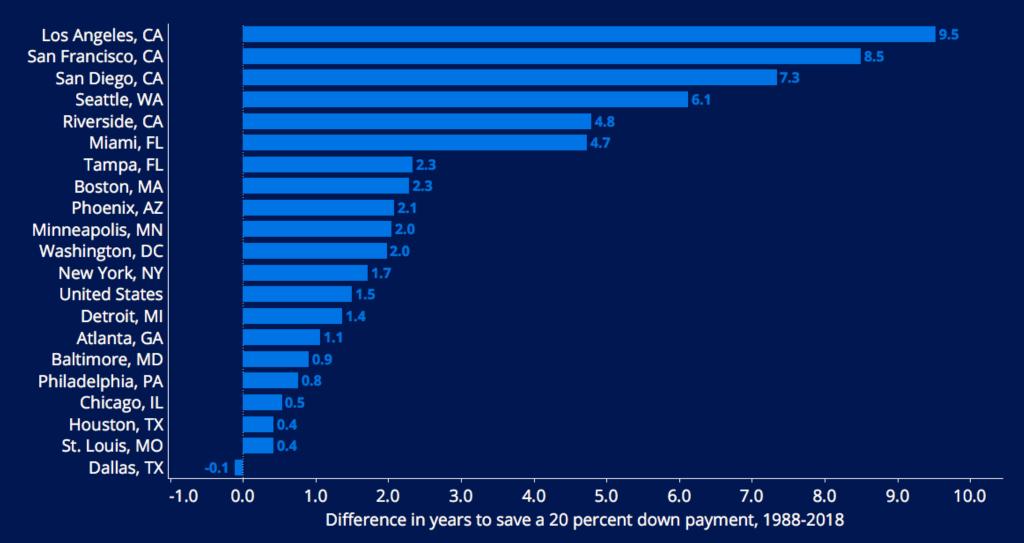

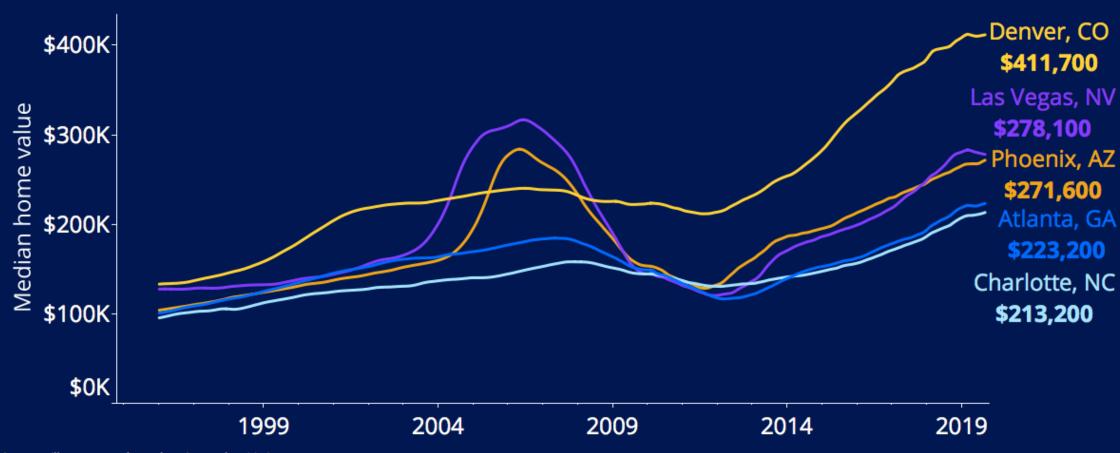

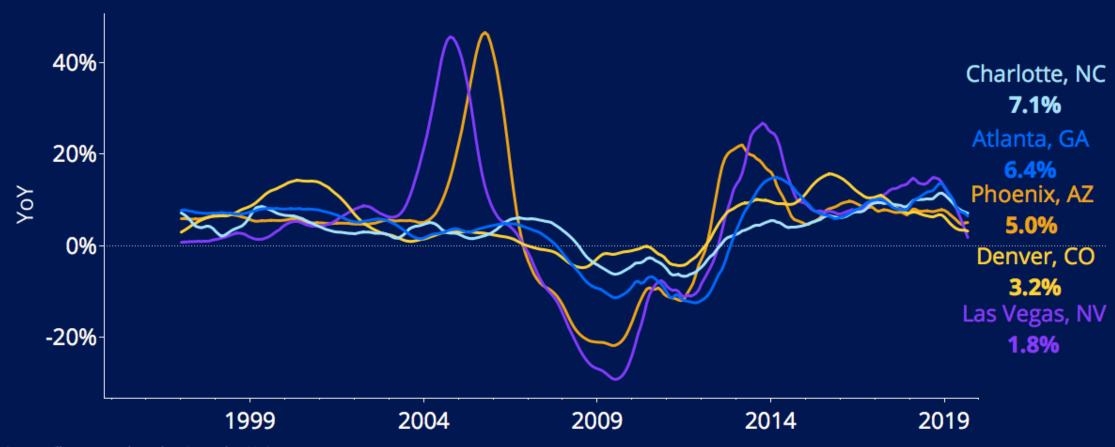

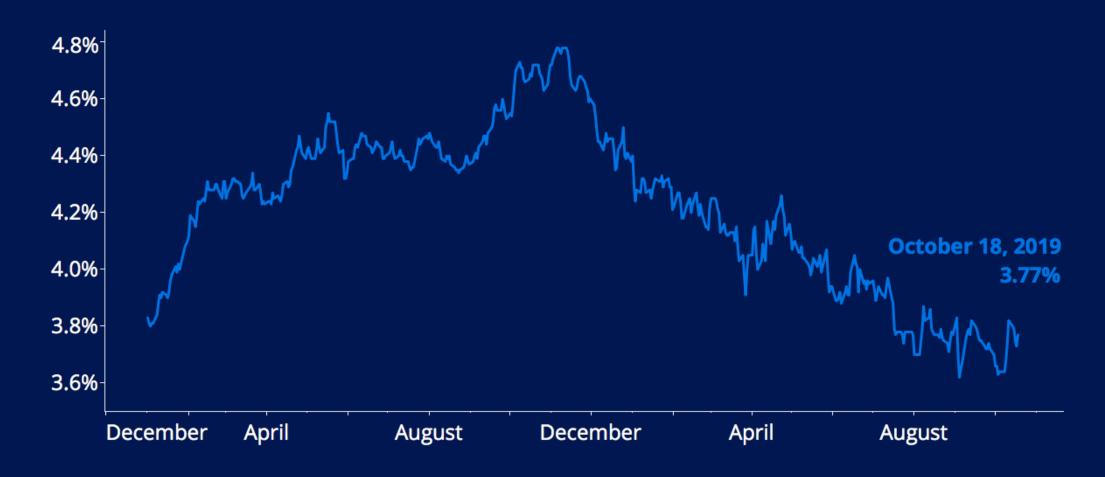

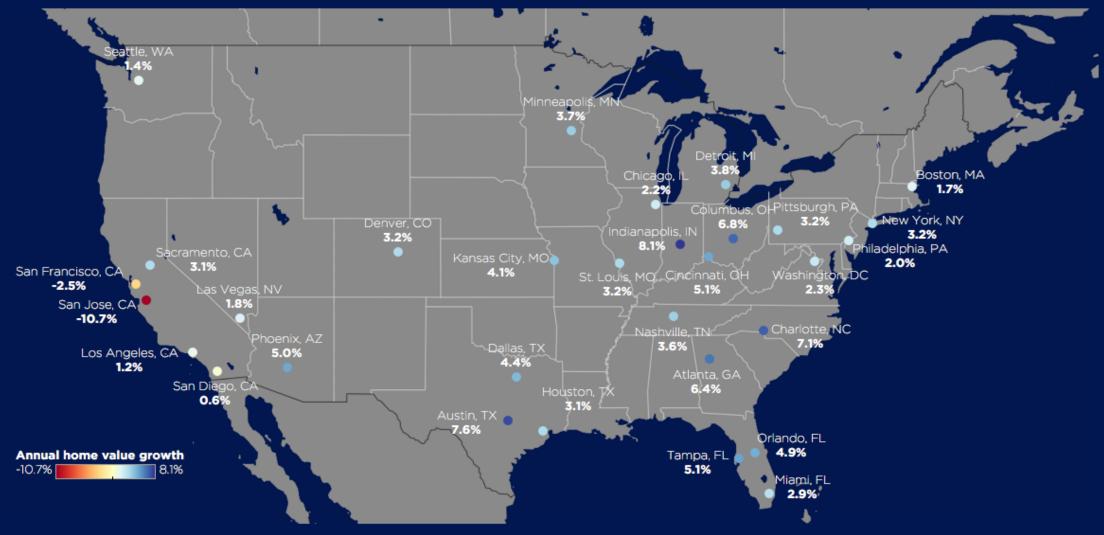

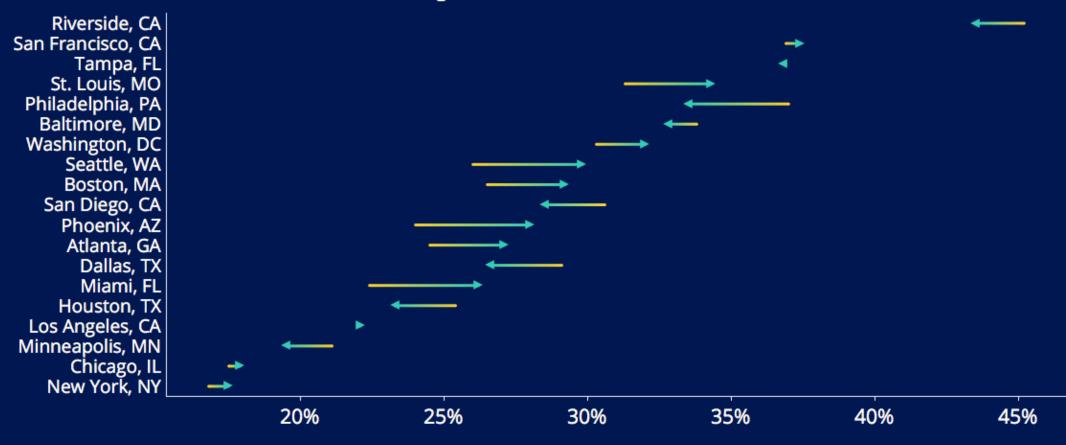


Significant variation in annual appreciation across the country

Share of searches for rentals in these metros that originate outside the area, in 2018 and 2019



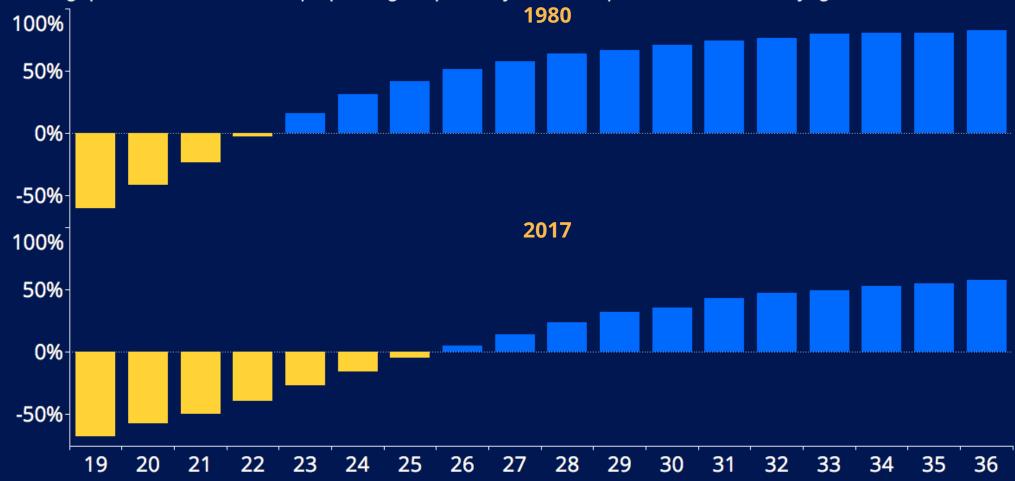

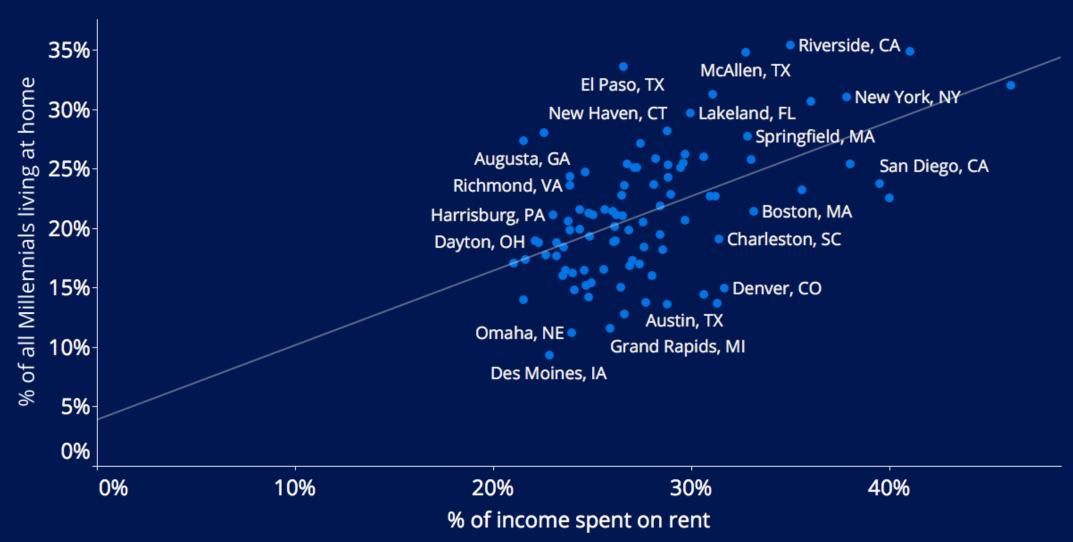

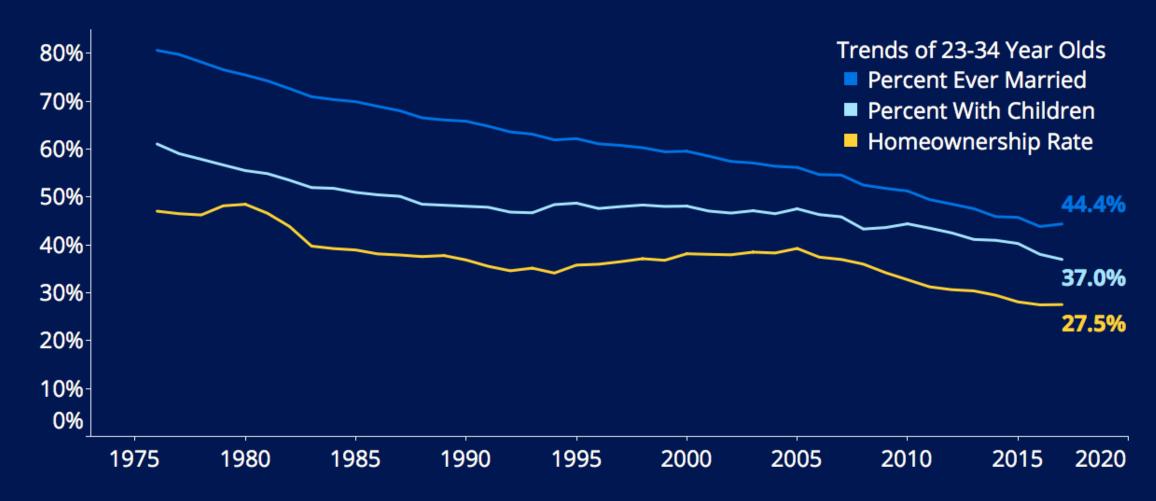
Percentage point difference in share of people living independently versus with parents or roommates, by age



More millennials live at home in places where rent consumes a larger share of income



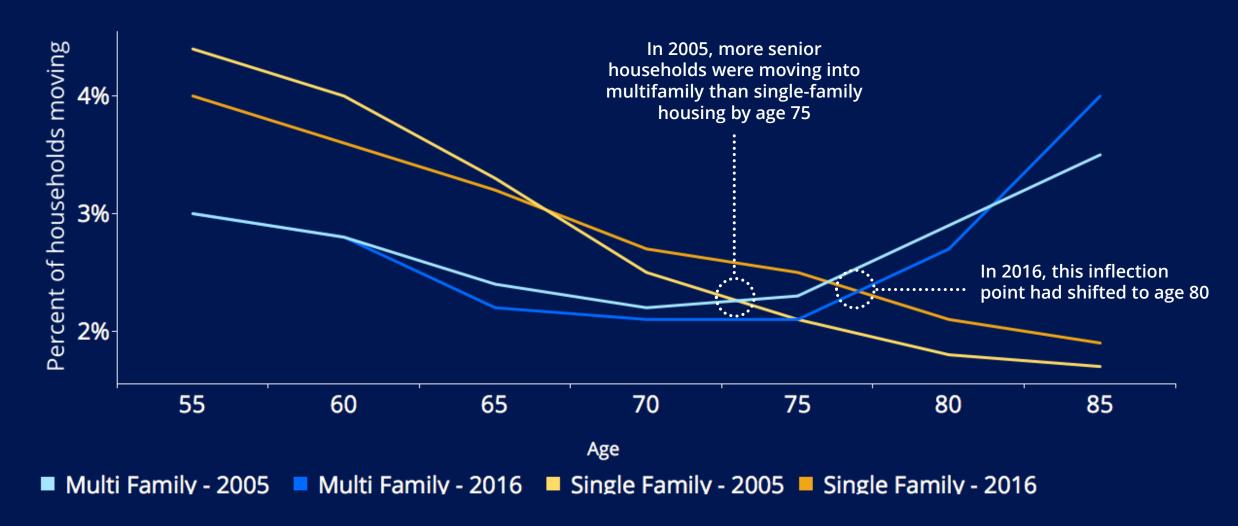
Indicators of adulthood are delayed in areas beyond housing too



Married couples with roommates more common

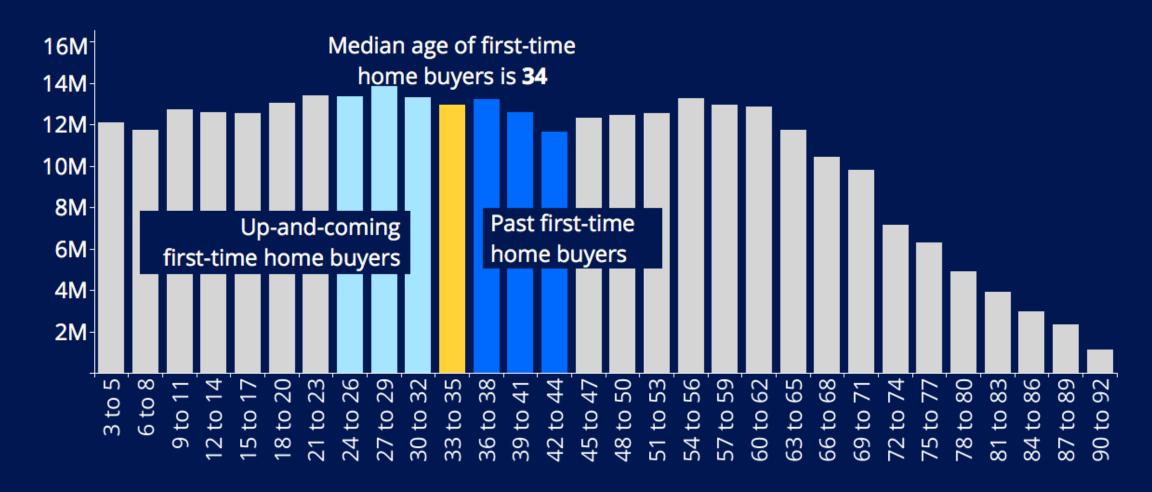
